Level A1/A2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)

This course is the last course in the beginner program. It covers topics including shopping, asking for medical assistance, describe an illness, talk about your job, and give advises and instructions. Speaking, listening and writing skills are consolidated and further expanded to cover the use of direct pronouns, the imperative and imperfetto past tense.

Outcomes

By the end of this course, you should be able to:

- ask for shopping assistance and describe clothes
- grocery shop
- describe a professional path
- describe small health problems and give advice
- talk about stress remedies and give advice
- ask for advice in a pharmacy.
